

RoHS Statement

In January 2003, the European Union passed the "Restriction on Use of Hazardous Substances" Directive, (RoHS), which will restrict the use of certain substances in Electrical and Electronic Products, including Lead (Pb), Mercury (Hg), Cadmium (Cd), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+), and certain Halide-containing Flame Retardants.

This directive applies to All Electrical and Electronic Products and their component parts, put onto the market after 1st July 2006.

Panorama Antennas has reviewed it's manufacturing processes and component supply chain and has implemented changes where necessary to ensure compliance.

All product supplied by Panorama Antennas from 1st April 2006 will be fully compliant with the RoHS Directive.
